Do Not Be Afraid



In today's Gospel narrative Jesus said to the Twelve, "Do not be afraid." In fact he tells them not to have fear three times. However, He tells them to, "Be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna," and that is God Himself. It is a wonderful thing Jesus does, after calling His apostles to follow Him, He tries to take away their fear. Our Lord knows that fear is the enemy of generous, heroic service. If Jesus is to call others to follow in the path before Him, He must first encourage them. He gives courage to replace fear. The courage He gives comes from a confidence in His promises.

Isn't this the dynamic that's operative in our lives as well?

When we reflect on what keeps us from a greater and deeper commitment to service of others, the answer is always, because of some unexplained fear. Fear is complicated. If we open up the various "excuses" or "the things that keep me from" a greater surrender of ourselves in love and service of others, somewhere underneath we always discover some fear. It's only natural.

Self-preservation is a good instinct. Without it, we would have no natural defenses to predators or enemies. Self-care is a good thing. Without it, we risk squandering the gifts of life God has given us. However, in a world in which there is no transcendent reality, that is no reality beyond the day to day battle for survival, "self" becomes the "ultimate" concern. This too is only natural. When Jesus says, "Do not be afraid," He is telling us that we can place our lives in His hands. He is telling us that He has already taken care of the ultimate "self-preservation." No one can ever take that away. We will live forever! We are only here on this earth, in this life, for a brief time. In helping us keep our ultimate goal and meaning in perspective, Jesus is empowering us with great freedom. Our hearts need not be occupied with ourselves. If we are liberated from this debilitating self-pre-occupation, we are freed to give our lives away, in great and heroic acts of love and service.

Imagine how different our lives could be, if in the face of self-centering-fear, we would pause and say, "Courage my soul; I don't need that fear; be brave; be free; trust in Jesus' tender care." Imagine if I "tuned out" or "turned off" the inner voice of self-absorption, and became absorbed in the needs of others. Can this be what Jesus meant when He said, "If you lose your life for my sake, you will find it?"

Question of the Day: *How will you serve others in need with your time, talent and treasure?*

Prayer: *Father of Mercy, forgive my failings and keep me in Your Grace. Lead me in the way of salvation. Give me strength in serving You as a follower of Jesus, our risen Lord, as I serve others in Your Holy Name. Amen.*





NEW! PREP REGISTRATION NEWS

Your family's PREP registration will be complete once the tuition is paid for the 2020-2021 school year. Payment can be made online on our PREP page or by check sent c/o PREP to our parish office.

The deadline for tuition payment is August 1.

Only students new to the program need to fill out the PREP registration online form on the parish website.
